







The following information is proposed to help clarify the Seminole County Public School dress code for 2010-11.

<p><b>HEAD:</b> No caps, visors, hoods, bandanas, sunglasses or other head gear may be worn on campus except with administrative permission.</p>	<p>ACCEPTABLE:</p> 	<p>NOT-ACCEPTABLE:</p> 
<p><b>UPPER GARMENTS:</b> All garments must have a collar or sleeves.</p> <p>Prohibited: halter tops, tube tops, backless dresses/tops, spaghetti straps and tank tops.</p>	<p>ACCEPTABLE:</p> 	<p>NOT-ACCEPTABLE:</p> 
<p><b>UPPER GARMENTS:</b> Shirts must touch, at a minimum the top portion of lower garments at all times.</p>	<p>ACCEPTABLE:</p> 	<p>NOT-ACCEPTABLE:</p> 
<p><b>LOWER GARMENTS:</b> Undergarments and the buttocks <b>MUST</b> remain entirely covered even while seated.</p>	<p>ACCEPTABLE:</p> 	<p>NOT-ACCEPTABLE:</p> 
<p><b>LOWER GARMENTS:</b> Dresses, skirts and shorts must be at least mid-thigh or below in length. Rips/tears above mid-thigh are not permitted.</p>	<p>ACCEPTABLE:</p> 	<p>NOT-ACCEPTABLE:</p>
