***Florida PTA Vision- Making every child's potential a reality***

1. Dr. Vogel presentation- SCPS Superintendent of Schools presents information to the school and community regarding the school budget crisis and the importance of extending the penny sales tax to help fund our schools. If the current sales tax is not extended, the School Board will ask for ½ cent sales tax for school use only. Future renovation of Wekiva Elementary will be dependent funds derived from this tax. A copy of the power point presentation is included with the hard copy of this report.
2. Committee Chair Reports- Damarys reports in the absence of committee chairs. Family Dinner is ready to go for next week. The sign in table for pre-ordered meals should be manned by Board members. We need at least four people to cover the time allowed.
3. Call to order- The meeting is called to order at 7:38 PM.
4. Approval of Summary- The summary is approved.
5. Ways and Means- Misa Mills reports that next year's Boosterthon fundraiser will kick off on September 28<sup>th</sup>. The Fun Run will take place on October 10<sup>th</sup>. JT will be our Team Leader again.
6. Treasurer's Report- Treasurer not in attendance. No report at this time.
7. Principal's Report- Mr. Pfeiffer reports on the Wekiva reaction to Dr. Vogel's presentation earlier this evening. The main questions from the audience seemed to revolve around the school's renovation and where on the list it will be prioritized. The ½ cent sales tax must pass for our best opportunity to get the remodel done. PTA needs to get the word out to the community that this is not a party issue, but one that affects everyone. Having a remodeled school benefits homeowners with or without children in the school since it adds approximately \$13,000 to a home's resale value. PTA should make an effort to attend School Board meetings to let them know that we are serious about our concerns.
8. Unfinished Business
  - a. Nominating Committee- Damarys reports that all positions are filled with the exception of Legislation. Contact will be made with potential nominees for this position.
9. New Business- Misa tells the Board that the Reflections awards have been ordered. They will be presented at the last PTA General Meeting on May 11<sup>th</sup>. It is agreed that the Board should have a table at the Family Dinner for information regarding the Sales Tax Initiative and a sign up sheet for those interested in attending a School Board meeting. Misa and Suzanne will work the table.
