Technology and the Future



- SMART boards in each classroom provide new ways to present activities designed to build problemsolving, logical thinking, and collaboration skills.
- CS2020 lessons are provided in K-5. Science and Tech are on the specials rotation K-5. Information Commons area provides time for coding and gaming.
- Computer Science 2020 Our students participate in at least 10 hours of computer science learning each school year.

Student Achievement 2021-2022 Data

- All students in grades K-5 participate in English and Language Arts (ELA) and Math iReady
 progress monitoring. 78% of K-5 students were on or above grade level in ELA and 76% of K5 students were on or above grade level in Math.
- The Star Early Literacy Assessment is administered to kindergarten students at the beginning of each school year. **69%** of students demonstrated kindergarten readiness compared to the state average of 57%.
